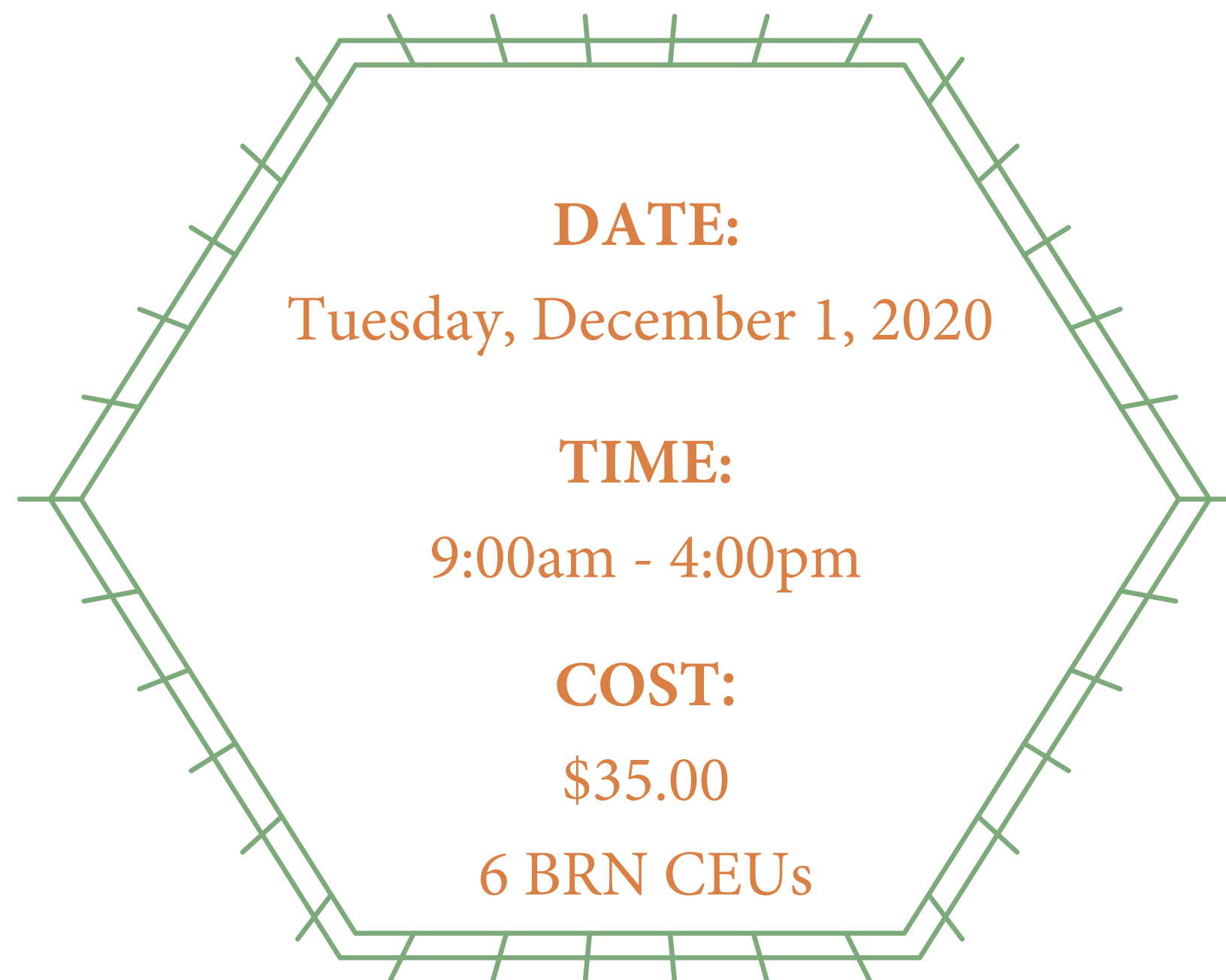
- Identify at least four specific tools to educate CNAs to control and support mental health and well-being.
